They can look at the tables as they start the process, but after a few repetitions, remove the printed copy of the tables and they'll find they can repeat the tables easily from memory. Once a table has been learned, give your child a test for that table. Each test in this book comes with an answer sheets, though as a parent (or teacher), you should really be able to mark these without the answers ;) When they've learned two sets of tables, give them a test that combines both of those tables into a single test. As more and more tables are learned, give them progressively more difficult tests to complete.
