Crib Scoring Rules

The crib is an extra hand created from discarded cards by each player and scored by the dealer. The rules for scoring the crib differ slightly from the hand, especially regarding flushes. Understanding these distinctions is important for accurate scoring.

Flush Requirements in the Crib

Unlike the hand, flushes in the crib require all five cards (the four crib cards plus the starter card) to be of the same suit to score points. A partial flush in the crib (four cards only) does not count, making flush scoring more restrictive in this phase.

Other Crib Scoring Notes

All other scoring rules, including fifteens, pairs, runs, and nobs, apply equally to the crib. The dealer must carefully evaluate the crib's cards to maximize scoring potential and anticipate the opponent's strategy.

Points Awarded in the Pegging Phase
