### PSORIASIS

### RASH

PUZZLES MAY USE SYNONYMS OR MORE TECHNICAL TERMS TO DESCRIBE SKIN PROBLEMS. BEING FAMILIAR WITH BOTH EVERYDAY AND MEDICAL VOCABULARY IS ADVANTAGEOUS. FOR EXAMPLE, “HIVES” MAY BE CLUED AS “URTICARIA.”

## USE CONTEXT CLUES FROM SURROUNDING ANSWERS

CROSSWORD GRIDS ALLOW INTERSECTING WORDS TO REVEAL LETTERS THAT CAN CONFIRM OR ELIMINATE POSSIBLE ANSWERS. USING THESE PARTIAL LETTERS HELPS PINPOINT THE CORRECT SKIN PROBLEM TERM.
