Considering the layers of dust covering the lid, it appeared that it had not been opened in many years. The lid seemed to creak and strain with the weight of the ages as I lifted the heavy oak. A neatly-folded Union Civil War uniform, complete with cap, stared up at me from the lost past. Although obviously worn, great care had been taken in its preservation. I gingerly lifted up the jacket and immediately noticed the three sergeant stripes on the upper arm. I knew then who had worn it. Powers lived till 1918 and my father, born in 1908, used to travel with his parents from Harrisburg to Lancaster to visit his grandfather where he would sit on the old gentlemans knee and be regaled with stories of Civil War Washington and the Lincolns. My father than passed these stories down to me.

The history and contributions of African Americans in northeast Indiana have been largely overlooked. This new publication, *African Americans in Fort Wayne: The First 200 Years*, does not claim to be a definitive history of the topic. It does, however, recognize and honor the pioneers who have made the African-American community in Fort Wayne what it is today. Through diary excerpts, oral histories, and studies of social organizations, religion, and community, a rich, 200-year heritage is vividly depicted. The story begins in 1794, when evidence points to the first black inhabitant of Fort Wayne. The first known, free black in the area was identified in 1809. During the early part of the 1800s, Indiana state funds partially financed a movement to send Indiana blacks to Liberia. Few left, and those who remained worked diligently to make Fort Wayne their own. The fruits of their labor can be partially seen in the development of the first black church, Turner Chapel A.M.E., which was started in 1849 and has been a pillar of the community since its completion. A migration of African Americans from the south, due to industrialization, greatly increased the population from 1913 through 1927, and new churches, organizations, and opportunities were developed. Today, the black community in Fort Wayne is rightfully proud of its extensive past.

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fort wayne history museum: War Monuments, Museums and Library Collections of 20th Century Conflicts Steve Rajtar, Frances Elizabeth Franks, 2015-07-11 This unique state-by-state directory covers monuments, memorials, museums, markers, statues and library collections that relate to the veterans, weapons, vehicles, airplanes, victims or any other aspect of war in which the United States participated. While a site may have been created before 1900 (such as a fort), there must be some operational or historical tie to a twentieth century conflict to be included here. General collections, such as museums of aviation, are included if they house materials related to a twentieth century conflict. The coverage is so thorough that statues honoring veterans of the Civil War appear if veterans of later wars are on their rosters of honorees. Another example of the comprehensiveness of this compilation is in the inclusion of memorials to victims of war such as the Holocaust Museum in Houston, Texas. For each site, the following information is given: street address, phone number, website and email address (if applicable), days and hours of operation, admission fees, other necessary information, and a brief description of the site.

They will be told that the Sa mi Museum and Northern Lapland Nature Centre was founded in Inari in 1961, which departments it houses as well as the name of its director - simply ask him or her any further questions directly, either by post, phone, fax or e-mail. The museums are coded by 22 categories identifying focus and type of each institution. The thematic scope ranges from 'Agricultural Museum' to 'Science and Tech Museum'. Searches are greatly facilitated by three indexes: the alphabetical index lists the names of all museums in the original language - and in English, too, if a translation is available. The index of names records artists whose works are shown

predominantly in a specific museum and/or refers to memorabilia of famous individuals from all walks of public life. Looking for 'Laurel, Stan', the user is given one entry (Laurel and Hardy Museum in Ulverston, UK), while 'Johann Wolfgang von Goethe' is not restricted to Frankfurt and Weimar but may be found in no fewer than 18 museums in Germany, France and Italy. Last but not least, the subject index classifies museums according to 214 subject groups (containing numerous further cross references), structured alphabetically by country and museum name. A standard work for museums, the art trade, centres of cultural studies, libraries and anybody searching for a specific museum for private, academic or business reasons.

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
