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turtles are surrendered to animal shelters or released into the wild, often in non-native habitats where they will cause problems as invasive species. Pet owners should fully understand the commitment required in properly caring for pet aquatic turtles. Thorough research regarding the right temperature, diet, lighting, tank size, and adult size should be conducted before selecting a species.

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yellow-bellied slider include: Hatchling Stage (0-1 year) Newly hatched turtles are about 1-1.5 inches in size. They have a soft shell that hardens with age. Diet consists mainly of protein-based foods such as small insects, larvae, and aquatic invertebrates. Juvenile Stage (1-4 years) Rapid growth occurs, with significant development in shell structure. Turtles start incorporating more plant matter into their diet. Increased activity and stronger territorial instincts develop. Adult Stage (5+ years) Shell reaches full size and hardens completely. Omnivorous diet continues, but adults consume more plant-based foods. Breeding behavior may emerge, particularly in females looking to nest. Proper care during each stage ensures a strong immune system, healthy bone development, and long-term vitality.

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
