Understanding the MCAT Scoring System

The MCAT comprises four sections: Chemical and Physical Foundations of Biological Systems, Critical Analysis and Reasoning Skills, Biological and Biochemical Foundations of Living Systems, and Psychological, Social, and Biological Foundations of Behavior. Each section is scored on a scale from 118 to 132, with the total score ranging from 472 to 528. The scoring is scaled, meaning raw scores

(the number of questions answered correctly) are converted to scaled scores to maintain consistency across different test versions and administrations.

Because of this scaling process, the exact number of questions correct to achieve a particular scaled score can vary slightly between test administrations. However, understanding the approximate raw score-to-scaled score conversion is essential for setting realistic score goals and estimating how many questions must be answered correctly to achieve them.

Scaled Scores Versus Raw Scores

Raw scores represent the total number of questions a test taker answers correctly. The MCAT does not penalize for incorrect answers, so there is no direct subtraction for wrong answers. Scaled scores adjust raw scores to account for minor differences in test difficulty, ensuring fairness. This process means that two students with the same raw score on different test dates may receive slightly different scaled scores.

Section Scores and Total Score

Each of the four MCAT sections is scored independently, and the total MCAT score is the sum of these four section scores. Achieving a high total score requires consistent performance across all sections, as a low score in one area can significantly impact the overall result.

How Many MCAT Questions Must Be Correct to Score Well?

Determining how many MCAT questions correct to score well depends on the target score and the specific section. Each section contains approximately 59 to 60 questions, and the total test has about 230 questions. To achieve a competitive score, test takers typically need to answer a large majority of questions correctly.

Approximate Raw Scores for Popular Score Benchmarks

While exact conversions change slightly with each exam, the following approximations provide guidance on how many questions need to be answered correctly per section to reach common score benchmarks:

- Score of 130 per section (total 520): Approximately 55–57 correct answers out of 59–60 questions.
- Score of 125 per section (total 500): Approximately 49–52 correct answers per section.
- Score of 120 per section (total 480): Approximately 40-45 correct answers.

These numbers illustrate that even a few missed questions can significantly influence the scaled score. Therefore, accuracy is crucial when aiming for top percentile scores.

Variability Across Sections

Some sections may be slightly more challenging than others depending on the test taker's background and preparation. It is essential to recognize which sections require more focused study to maximize the number of correct answers and improve the overall MCAT score.

If a question is not immediately answerable, it is beneficial to use educated guessing rather than leaving it blank. Employing process of elimination before guessing improves the odds of a correct response.

Impact of Leaving Questions Blank

Unanswered questions do not contribute to the raw score and therefore reduce the maximum potential scaled score. Maximizing the number of answered questions, even if some are guesses, is generally advantageous.
