OVERVIEW OF THE TAMU POLITICAL SCIENCE DEGREE PLAN

THE TAMU POLITICAL SCIENCE DEGREE PLAN IS DESIGNED TO OFFER A THOROUGH GROUNDING IN THE DISCIPLINE OF POLITICAL SCIENCE, COMBINING THEORETICAL FRAMEWORKS WITH PRACTICAL INSIGHTS. THE PROGRAM PROVIDES STUDENTS WITH THE TOOLS NEEDED TO ANALYZE POLITICAL BEHAVIOR, INSTITUTIONS, AND POLICIES ON LOCAL, NATIONAL, AND GLOBAL SCALES. IT EMPHASIZES THE DEVELOPMENT OF CRITICAL THINKING, RESEARCH METHODOLOGIES, AND EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION SKILLS. TEXAS AFM'S CURRICULUM REFLECTS CURRENT POLITICAL CHALLENGES AND TRENDS, PREPARING STUDENTS TO ENGAGE WITH CONTEMPORARY ISSUES IN POLITICS AND GOVERNANCE. THE DEGREE PLAN IS SUITABLE FOR THOSE INTERESTED IN CAREERS IN PUBLIC SERVICE, LAW, ACADEMIA, AND BEYOND.

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS AND COURSE STRUCTURE

STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE TAMU POLITICAL SCIENCE DEGREE PLAN MUST COMPLETE A SERIES OF REQUIRED COURSES, ELECTIVES, AND GENERAL EDUCATION CREDITS TO GRADUATE. THE CURRICULUM IS STRUCTURED TO ENSURE A SOLID FOUNDATION IN POLITICAL SCIENCE PRINCIPLES ALONGSIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR ACADEMIC EXPLORATION.

CORE CURRICULUM

THE CORE CURRICULUM ESTABLISHES THE FUNDAMENTAL KNOWLEDGE BASE NECESSARY FOR POLITICAL SCIENCE MAJORS. IT TYPICALLY INCLUDES COURSES IN POLITICAL THEORY, COMPARATIVE POLITICS, INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS, AND AMERICAN GOVERNMENT. THESE COURSES INTRODUCE ESSENTIAL CONCEPTS AND METHODOLOGIES THAT UNDERPIN THE STUDY OF POLITICS.

CREDIT HOUR REQUIREMENTS

The degree plan usually requires completion of approximately 120 credit hours, which includes general education, major-specific courses, and electives. Within the major, students often need to complete around 36 to 42 credit hours focused on political science subjects.

GENERAL EDUCATION AND ELECTIVES

In addition to major requirements, students must fulfill Texas Afm's general education requirements, which cover disciplines such as humanities, social sciences, natural sciences, and communication. Electives provide flexibility for students to pursue related interests or deepen their knowledge in particular areas of political science.

SPECIALIZATIONS AND ELECTIVE OPTIONS

TAMU'S POLITICAL SCIENCE DEGREE PLAN OFFERS VARIOUS AREAS OF SPECIALIZATION THAT ALLOW STUDENTS TO TAILOR THEIR STUDIES TO SPECIFIC INTERESTS WITHIN THE FIELD. THESE TRACKS HELP STUDENTS DEVELOP EXPERTISE AND PREPARE FOR TARGETED CAREER PATHS.

AMERICAN POLITICS AND POLICY

This specialization focuses on the structures, processes, and policies of the United States government. Courses examine electoral politics, public policy analysis, and the workings of federal, state, and local government institutions.

COMPARATIVE POLITICS

THE COMPARATIVE POLITICS TRACK EXPLORES POLITICAL SYSTEMS AND BEHAVIORS ACROSS DIFFERENT COUNTRIES AND REGIONS. STUDENTS STUDY POLITICAL REGIMES, DEVELOPMENT, DEMOCRATIZATION, AND CONFLICT TO GAIN A GLOBAL PERSPECTIVE.

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

THIS AREA EMPHASIZES THE INTERACTIONS BETWEEN NATIONS, INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS, AND GLOBAL ISSUES SUCH AS SECURITY, DIPLOMACY, AND INTERNATIONAL LAW. IT PREPARES STUDENTS FOR CAREERS IN DIPLOMACY, INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS, AND GLOBAL POLICY ANALYSIS.

PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION AND POLICY

STUDENTS INTERESTED IN GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS AND PUBLIC SECTOR MANAGEMENT MAY CHOOSE THIS SPECIALIZATION. IT COVERS TOPICS SUCH AS PUBLIC BUDGETING, ORGANIZATIONAL THEORY, AND POLICY IMPLEMENTATION.

ELECTIVE COURSES

INTERNSHIPS

Internship programs connect students with governmental agencies, non-profit organizations, political campaigns, and think tanks. These internships provide practical experience and networking opportunities essential for career development.

UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH

STUDENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO PARTICIPATE IN RESEARCH UNDER FACULTY MENTORSHIP. RESEARCH PROJECTS ALLOW STUDENTS TO INVESTIGATE POLITICAL PHENOMENA USING QUALITATIVE AND QUANTITATIVE METHODS, ENHANCING THEIR ANALYTICAL SKILLS AND ACADEMIC CREDENTIALS.

HOW MANY CREDIT HOURS ARE NEEDED TO COMPLETE THE POLITICAL SCIENCE DEGREE AT TEXAS AGM?

To graduate with a Political Science degree from Texas AGM, students must complete approximately 120 credit hours, including general education, major requirements, and electives.
